

JOINT CLUB SERVICE RIFLE MATCHES

The regularly scheduled Joint Club Service Rifle matches with Newberg Rifle and Pistol Club (NRPC) and Chehalem Valley Sportsman Club (CVSC) are held on the second Saturday of each month in March through October. All matches are held at the CVSC range in Dundee, Oregon. Match instructions, set-up and squad assignments will begin at 8:00 AM. or at a time to be announced prior to that month's match. Matches held in July and August will be practice sessions or a special "fun time" and will not be scored or require an entry fee. The winner of the 2008 match series will be recognized at years end. The 2008 match series will be scored as the 4 highest scores of the 6 scored matches held for the year.

Junior shooters and non-club members are welcome to participate.

An Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement form must be filled out and signed with a Notary Public witness prior to shooting your first match. **This is a one time agreement** which the club will keep on file for future participations. MATCH SUMMARY:

- **SERVICE RIFLE** – Any repeating rifle of semi-automatic or bolt action capable of a sustained fire string of 10 rounds with one reloading. The rifle must be of the type issued for National Defense and using metallic sights.
- **ENTRY FEE** - \$10
- **RIFLE CLASSES** –
 - Vintage - pre 1957 Service Rifle types (Springfield '03, M1 Garand, Mauser 98, etc.)
 - Modern - post 1957 Service Rifle types (M1A, AR-15, etc)
- **COURSE OF FIRE** – 5 ± sighters, plus 40 rounds (see table below)

POSSIBLE SCORE400

- **EQUIPMENT:** -
 - Mandatory:
 - Hearing and Eye protection.
 - Chamber Safety Flag.
 - Recommended: (could be shared with another shooter)
 - Spotting Scope or Binoculars
 - Shooting Mat and Jacket
- **ARMS & AMMUNITION** – Each shooter to provide own rifle and ammunition. Exception – A limited number of Club owned M-1 rifles are available for use. Surplus CMP issued ammunition is available for a nominal cost for those shooting caliber 30-06. Please contact the Match Director prior to the match if you intend to use a club owned rifle or purchase ammunition
- **REPORTING TO THE LINE** -**Uncase your unloaded weapon at your vehicle and proceed to the shooting area with your weapon's action locked and open displaying the chamber safety flag and report to the Match Director.**
